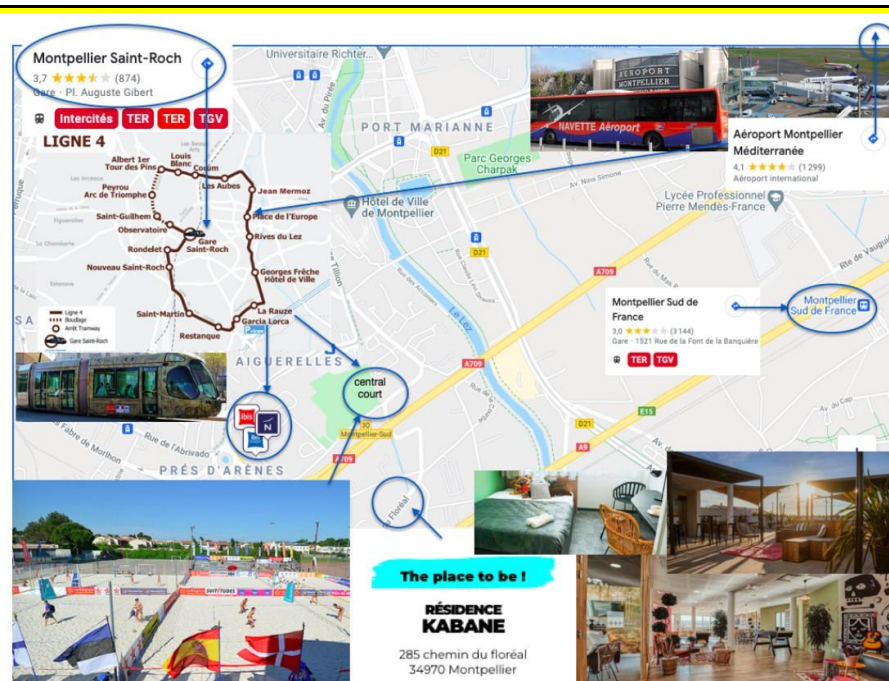

ATHLETES & DELEGATION	Each Club participates with an official delegation of a minimum of 4 and maximum 6 players and up to 2 delegation members.																																																		

MEMBERS QUOTA	One delegation member (NFs Delegate, coach, or athlete when necessary) is identified as Head of Delegation during the Preliminary Inquiry and will be the contact person for all competition matters and for identifying the composition of the team in case of a Golden Set. Additional Delegation members must be announced to the Operational Director.
ACCREDITATION	Organizers will ensure that all Organizing Committee members, Officials, referees, players, coaches, physiotherapists, VIP's, journalists, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, will be able to access the designated venue areas
PRELIMINARY INQUIRY MEETINGS	Main Draw Preliminary Inquiry on: Thursday 25th June, 6 to 7pm at Montpellier Beach Volley Club Players and Delegation members are required to attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present their IDs / passports and playing uniforms. There is no Technical Meeting. All information will be provided during the Preliminary Inquiry.
COMPETITION SCHEDULE	Playing Pool Play on Friday 26th June and single elimination phase on Saturday 27th June 2026 Full competition days, starting 8.30 am and finishing in the evening. Competition schedule and format subject to final team signups.
PRIZE MONEY (PER TEAM)	2500 EUR per gender
COMPETITION FORMAT	The competition format will consist of 2 phases: pool play following single elimination. One hour before their respective match the Head of Delegation has to give the team list to the competition director. Pool play phase: Match Club v Club consists of two games played by teams of each club. 2 points will be given for a win and 1 for a loss. Single elimination phase: Match Club vs Club consists of two games played by teams of each Club. In case of a tie, a Golden set shall be played to 15 points. The golden set must be played by a combination of players that has not played together yet in the current match. Each game is played through 2 sets to 21 points and if needed, a third set to 15 points. 1 substitution per match is allowed, as per Beach Volley European Cup Competition Format. Pool play composition and following single elimination phase to be determined upon confirmation of registered clubs. Competition schedule to be confirmed at the Preliminary Inquiry. The winner of each gender in the WEVZA Club competition qualifies for the CEV Beach Volleyball European Cup Preliminary Phase!

NUMBER OF CLUBS	Minimum 3 clubs from 3 different NFs Maximum 12 clubs per gender - 1 spots reserved for all WEVZA NFs - 1 additional spot for host country - Further spots will be allocated following the CEV Beach Volley European Cup Country Ranking

SEEDING	Clubs will be seeded after the CEV Beach Volley European Cup Country ranking. In case of same points or no points a Drawing of Lots will be conducted following the end of the Preliminary Inquiry to detail the seed for each club. Clubs from the same National Federation will be allocated in different pools where possible.
