PRELIMINARY INQUIRY & TECHNICAL MEETING	<p>Preliminary Inquiry: <u>Friday 3rd of October from 19:00 to 20:00 at Montpellier Beach Volley</u></p> <p>Each Club has to be present with the full Delegation at Preliminary Inquiry.</p> <p>Players and Delegation members are required to present their passports, uniforms and accessories. Only people accredited through the respective CEV forms will be acknowledged as delegation members.</p> <p>A technical meeting will be organised after the Preliminary Inquiry and needs to be attended by the Head of Delegation of each Club, to detail all competition parameters.</p>
UNIFORMS	<p><u>The Organiser will not provide uniforms to the participating Clubs</u></p> <p>Participating Clubs shall provide their players with uniforms (tank top and shorts) in different colors according to the layout specified in the competition Official Communications n.1 document and may exploit them commercially excluding the following product categories: alcohol (spirits), tobacco & pornography.</p> <p><u>The uniforms of each Club need to be numbered from 1 to 6 and each athlete will bear the same uniform number throughout the competition.</u></p> <p><u>For the production of athletes uniforms the Event and the CEV logo are available in the CEV Cloud https://cloud.cev.eu/url/jqssfup7ryiqjhqs.</u></p> <p>Athletes may use gear and accessories as defined in the CEV Beach Volleyball Guidelines.</p> <p>Coaches entering the Field of Play, need to abide to in regards to uniform the provisions of the CEV Coaching Regulations document, available in the Beach Volley European Cup section of the CEV website.</p>
SEEDING	<p>Clubs will be seeded in the competition as per the seeding communicated in the CEV Beach Volley European Cup Official Communications No3.</p>
COMPETITION FORMAT & SCHEDULE	<p>Competition parameters and format including order of matches are detailed in the competition Official Communications document N.4</p> <p>Event will be played over 2 days</p>
OFFICIAL TRAINING	<p>Training courts will be available on site on Friday 3 October</p> <p>Please note that reservation of 1 hour training can be made from Each Club by contacting <u>Julien Prigent - montpellier.beachvolley@gmail.com</u></p>
RULES OF THE GAME	<p>According to the FIVB Official Beach Volleyball rules in their latest edition.</p> <p><u>Exceptions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>Coaching:</u> The presence of a coach inside the field of play is allowed provided that the person is accredited through the respective CEV BV-05 form. - <u>Substitution:</u> Each club is entitled to 1 substitution per match (an athlete may leave the game and re-enter only once, and only to same athlete), in line with the provisions of the Official Communications document N.1
TRANSPORT	<p>Participating Clubs are responsible for their own international and domestic transportation and for any further expenses such as visa or airport taxes.</p>
OFFICIAL DAYS ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE	<p><u>Arrival for all Clubs:</u> Friday 3 October</p> <p><u>Departure for all Clubs:</u> following end of competition</p>
BOARD AND LODGING	<p>As per the event Official Communication, each Club is responsible to cover their accommodation costs.</p>

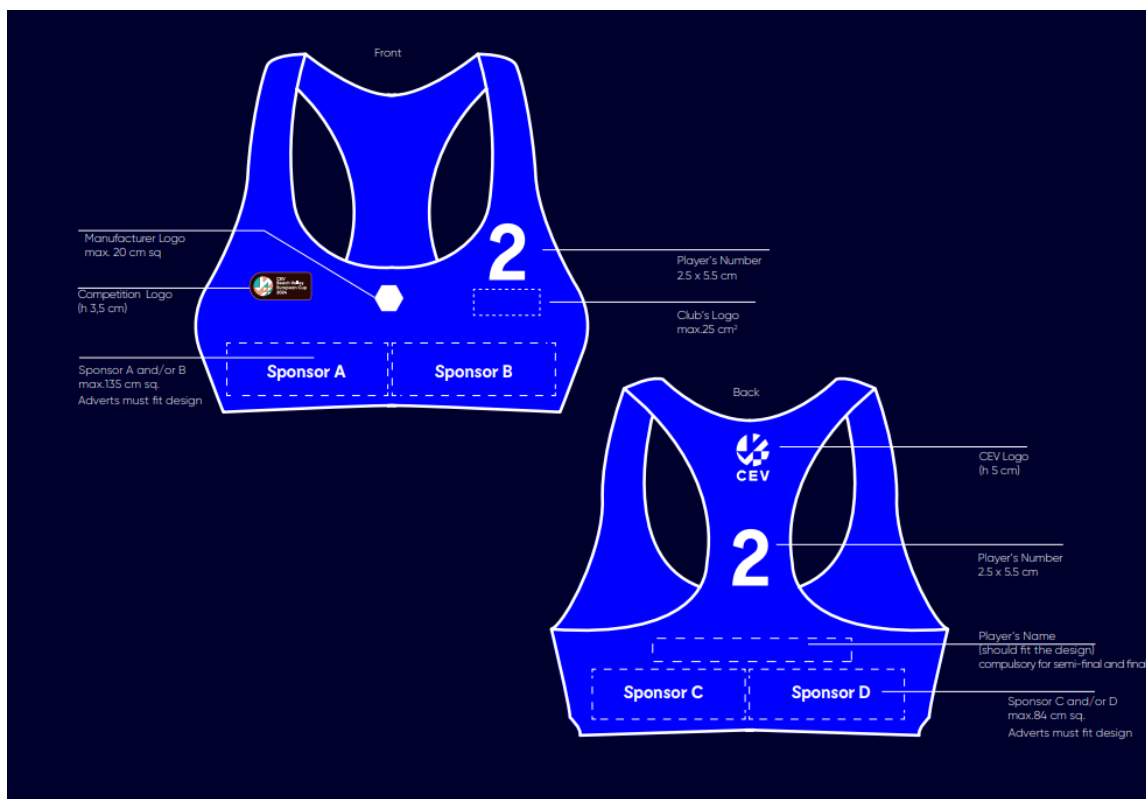
