RIGHT OF PARTICIPATION & REGISTRATION	<p>An athlete wishing to take part in a CEV sanctioned competition must possess the nationality of the country he/she intends to represent and must fully comply with the requirements laid down by the FIVB Sports Regulations. In addition, each athlete needs to have the following documentation completed/updated on his/her VIS profile:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • present the SV-01 Player's Commitment form during the Preliminary Inquiry and M-3 or BVB/10 Annual Health Certificate forms to his/her VIS profile • have completed the FIVB Anti-Doping education programme "Play Clean", and the Prevention of Competition Manipulation course that can be found here <p>Athletes' wishing to participate shall be aged under 20 years on 31st of December of the year during which the respective Championships is held (for this season born on 1st of January 2006 or after).</p>	
SUBSTITUTION OF A PLAYER	In the CEV Age Group Snow Volleyball European Championships a National Federation may substitute more than one Player per Team up to the Preliminary Inquiry that the team is due to attend, without any consequences but shall inform the CEV about it, by providing the relevant CEV form.	
PRELIMINARY INQUIRIES AND TECHNICAL MEETING	<p>Athletes are required to attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present their passports, Health Certificate, SV-01 form Player's Commitment and uniforms/accessories.</p> <p>Main Draw Preliminary Inquiry Women: 06.03.2025 – Venue-conference room – 18:30 - 20:00 Men: 06.03.2025 – Venue-conference room – 18:30 - 20:00</p> <p>The Technical Meeting and the pools composition draw will be held immediately after the end of the Preliminary Inquiry.</p>	
TRAINING SESSIONS	Please note that reservation of training can be made one day in advance for the next day only and each team is entitled to make one reservation per day. Additional training session may be available only if the courts will be available.

COMPETITION FORMAT AND SCHEDULE	<p>The competition format and schedule will be defined based on the number of registered teams. A minimum of 3 matches per teams will be guaranteed.</p> <p>Planned format: Pool play followed by a single elimination.</p> <p>Best of 3 sets for all matches, sets until 15 points with a minimum 2 points lead.</p>

ADMISSION AND SEEDING	<p>All National Federations will be seeded according to the CEV U20 Snow Volleyball Country Ranking, as defined in the CEV Snow Volleyball Competitions Regulations. National Federation without ranking points will be drawn into the pools without any preconditions, unless obliged to be relocated in the next possible position in the sequence of the serpentine system to avoid having teams from the same country in the same pool. The first host country team must be seeded in position 1 in Pool A.</p>
CONTRIBUTION FEE	<p>As per the Official Communication No.1 document, a contribution fee is a fee paid for each Main Draw team delegation member to the organiser in order to contribute to its accommodation and local transportation.</p> <p>Delegation members are considered a minimum of three (3) maximum of four (4) players, depending how many players the respective National Federation registered for the Championship, and optionally up to one (1) team manager/coach per team. For the CEV Age Group Snow Volleyball European Championships this amount equals EUR 100 (one hundred Euros) per team delegation member per day, starting from the official arrival day until the official departure day, even if the duration of the stay of its delegation is shorter.</p> <p>For additional team member(s) rate is communicated in the Board & Lodging section.</p> <p>The respective National Federation shall pay the fee 7 days before the start of the event to the following bank account of the organiser:</p> <p>Account holder: Net Masters IBAN: PL 83 1600 1462 1715 1013 1000 0003 BIC: PPABPLPK Bank name: BNP Paribas Bank Address: ul. Kasprzaka 2, 01-211 Warszawa</p> <p>If the organiser will not receive the contribution fees in full in time, the CEV Supervisor has the right to exclude the concerned teams from the event.</p> <p>Each participating National Federation has to present a copy of the confirmed bank transfer to the CEV Supervisor at the Preliminary Inquiry.</p> <p>Every person is responsible for any and all extra expenses at the hotel such as mini-bar, phone calls, laundry, etc. These expenses must be paid at checkout time.</p>
LICENSE FEE	<p>For each athlete participating in a CEV Snow Volleyball competition in 2025 the respective National Federation shall pay, upon receipt of the respective CEV invoice, a license fee amounting to 50, - EUR per athlete.</p>
RULES OF THE GAME	<p>FIVB Snow Volleyball Rules</p> <p><u>Exceptions – Coaching</u>: the presence of a coach inside the field of play is allowed in CEV Age Group Snow Volleyball European Championships, provided that accreditation requests are duly upload to the CEV Cloud and in time accredited through the respective SV-05 form. UNIFORMS	<p>The organiser will provide jersey (top only) to the participating teams. As per the provisions of the CEV Snow Volleyball Guidelines, the participating teams are responsible to bring their own long tight pants or shorts and close fitting long or short sleeves t-shirts. The uniforms must be consistent in style, length and colour for all athletes in the team.</p> <p>Athletes may use gear and accessories as defined in the CEV Snow Volleyball Guidelines.</p>
OFFICIAL DAYS, VENUE OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE	<p>Arrival for Main Draw teams: 06 of March.2025 Official Venue of Arrival and Departure: Wrocław Nicolaus Copernicus Airport (WRO) Departure of Main Draw teams: 10 of March.2025</p>
VISA	<p>Team delegation members (Athletes, Coach or Head of Delegation and / or Doctor / Physiotherapist), NF members, etc. are responsible to apply early enough for their visas, whenever needed. The Hosting National Federation should be contacted for any official invitation letter request.</p>
ACCREDITATION	<p>Organisers will provide the local committee members, CEV officials, referees, players, team official (coach / head of delegation), technical staff with official accreditation cards and will ensure that only those people will have access the designated areas. An individual is considered a team official when his/her accreditation request is duly submitted, fulfil all the requirements, and hold an accreditation for a competition.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT	<p>Athletes, coaches, head of delegation, NF members, etc. are responsible for their own international and domestic airfare/travel costs and for any further expenses such as visa or airport taxes.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Transportation from the official venue of arrival to the official hotel for players and up to one accredited delegation member per team is organised by the local organiser on the official days of arrival and departure mentioned above.</p> <p>For extra persons and extra days please see conditions as explained in Board And Lodging section.</p> <p>Participating NFs are responsible to upload their travel information to the CEV Cloud at the latest by 23.02.2024 (-7 days).</p> <p>Late submission may lead to inability to offer the service.</p> <p>Link: https://cloud.cev.eu/url/U20SVECHs2025Travel</p>
