1. Introduction

The European Volleyball Confederation is pleased to open the registration procedure for the CEV U19 Women / U20 Men Volleyball European Championship 2022.

The organisers for the Final Round are confirmed as:

- Men – Messina and Reggio Calabria (ITA) dates: 16-24/09/2022
- Women – Skopje (MKD) dates: 27/08-04/09/2022

All other National Federations will compete in qualifying rounds scheduled for 2022 to book their places in the Final Round that will be played with 12 teams.

The competition format for the 2022 edition remains the same as the 2020 edition and as explained in the Article 4.

This Championship will be managed and processed via the CEV database and therefore we ask all National Federations to apply the necessary accuracy while working with it.

It remains the sole responsibility of the NFs to respect all Communications, Regulations, Guidelines and institutional decisions to guarantee the delivery of correct, accurate and complete data at any time that these are required.

The regulations in force are the newly updated 'CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations', as well as the last version of the 'CEV Organisation Guidelines for National Team Competitions' which can be found here:

2. Age Limit

According to the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations, the CEV U19/U20 Volleyball European Championship 2022 will only be open to:

Female players (U19):

Born on 1st January 2004 or thereafter

Male players (U20):

Born on 1st January 2003 or thereafter

3. Registration procedure and deadline

The registration for this edition will be done through the CEV Database using the following form:

01CH (Team Registration)

The registration deadline for closing and sending the above-mentioned form is:

Monday, September 13, 2021 at 23:59 CEST

After closing the form on-line, National Federations must click 'Print Form' and then sign and stamp the paper copy and send it by post to the CEV Office.

On this form there are tick boxes to inform CEV if the respective National Federation intends to apply to organise one of the 1st or 2nd Round qualification tournaments. However, the definitive application forms and required procedure for applying to organise a tournament will be sent to all NFs after the registrations are confirmed in Official Communication No. 2.

4. Competition format and dates

The 2022 competition will be structured as follows:

In all cases, teams are allocated according to the latest respective CEV European Ranking (01/12/2020).

1st Round

A 1st Round will only be played if more than 30 teams register for men's or women's competition. If played, the 1st Round will follow the single round robin tournament format.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Depending on the definite number of teams registered – 1 up to 8 1st Round Pools will be organised. Each 1st Round tournament will be played with a minimum of 3 [three] teams and a maximum of 4 [four] teams (*).
- The eventual tournament winners will qualify to the 2nd Round; further vacancies may be available depending on the total number of registered teams and the number of pools in the 1st and 2nd Round.

2nd Round

The 2nd Round will be played using the single round robin tournaments format (i.e. 1 tournament "one against each other"). The number of teams qualifying from the 1st to the 2nd Round will depend on the number of teams registering.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Depending on the definite number of teams registered – 1 up to 8 2nd Round Pools will be organised.
- Each 2nd Round tournament will be played with minimum 3 [three] and maximum 4 [four] teams (*).

- The 4 [four] teams in each 2nd Round pool will play 1 [one] tournament (3 competition days in each with 2 matches per day = single round robin).
- Each of the four National Federations involved has the right to apply for the organisation of the tournament.
- Should more than one National Federation apply for the organisation, the organisers will be drawn by the CEV.
- Should less than one National Federation apply for the organisation, the organiser will be drawn by the CEV.
- In each pool, the first placed team qualifies to the Final round.
- Eight best placed teams not qualified to the Final Round from the 2nd Round will qualify to the 3rd Round.

3rd Round

The 3rd Round will be played using the single round robin tournaments format (i.e. 1 tournament “one against each other”).

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Two pools will be organised and will be played with 4 [four] teams each.
- The 4 [four] teams in each 3rd Round pool will play 1 [one] tournament (3 competition days in each with 2 matches per day = single round robin).
- Each of the 4 [four] National Federations involved in the pool has the right to apply for the organisation of the tournament.
- Should more than 1 [one] National Federation apply for the organisation, the organisers will be drawn by the CEV.
- Should less than 1 [one] National Federation apply for the organisation, the organiser will be drawn by the CEV.
- The eventual tournament winners will qualify to the Final Round.

(*) The method to define the best second team when facing a non-equal number of the teams over the pools we discard the results of the matches with the lowest placed team to compare all runners-up performances based on the equal number of matches.

The CEV holds the right to adjust the Competition format according to the number of registered teams per respective Rounds.

5. Allocation of Participating Teams

Teams will be allocated to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Round according to the CEV European Ranking (from 01/12/2020) of the concerned age group. The pools will be determined as per the serpentine system for each round also based on the relevant CEV European Ranking. The organisers are seeded as the head of those pools.

CEV EUROPEAN RANKING:

For the CEV U19/U20 European Championship 2022, the CEV European Ranking (as released in December 2020) will be used to list teams and subsequently place them into the specific Rounds.

6. FIVB World Championship 2023 (U20 Women /U21 Men)

The highest classified teams, not already qualified, from the CEV U19W/U20M Volleyball European Championship 2022 will qualify for the respective FIVB U20 Women / U21 Men Volleyball World Championships 2023 according to the vacancies granted by FIVB to Europe per gender. The vacancies are still to be announced by FIVB and information shall be provided in due course by FIVB.

The organiser will be set as head of the pools, after that the Serpentine System with a respective Ranking positions is applied to set the pools. The NFs that are sharing the same Ranking position will be allocated considering the geographical location if possible.

To define the best second placed teams when facing a non-equal number of the teams over the pools, we discard the results of the matches with the lowest placed team to compare all runners-up performances based on the equal number of matches.

RESERVED PRODUCT CATEGORIES:

The CEV reserves the following product categories:

1. Airlines
2. Banking
3. Betting and Gambling services*
4. Body & Healthcare products
5. Courier services & logistics
6. Data
7. Sports Equipment - Volleyballs and flooring*
8. Sportswear

The CEV may release one or more of the above-mentioned categories, upon written request of the National federation.

***In any case, the categories n°3, n°6 and n°7 will not be released. Advertisement of betting & gambling partners, whether direct or indirect, is not allowed in the frame of the competition, except for advertising on player uniforms (jersey) on the positions foreseen as per FIVB Events regulations.**

*For the avoidance of doubt, although the "Betting & gambling services" sector and/or category is reserved by the CEV, the Organiser may exploit, based on prior agreement of the CEV, the category for the "National lottery", provided that their sports betting operations are in no way presented under the same brand as their National lottery operations. Thus, gambling and betting services are prohibited and the category will not be released by the CEV.

The CEV partner is the ultimate betting rights holder on a global basis in relation to the National team and Club competitions, including the CEV Volleyball U19/20 European Championship.

5. Media rights & Digital Coverage (2nd and 3rd Round)

Media Rights & Production standards

The production of matches in relation the CEV U19 Women / U20 Men Volleyball European Championship 2022 Qualifiers are optional.

In case the appointed National Federations wish to produce matches of the CEV Competition, the CEV is granting to the National Federations the non-exclusive domestic media rights in relation only to the matches organized by the National Federations in their host territory in exchange of the production of such matches in accordance with the CEV standards indicated in *Section 7: Media Production* of the CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations. There is no media rights reciprocity allowed between organizing National Federations.

The National Federations are allowed to live stream matches of the CEV Competition (i.e. the matches being produced in their territory) in their digital platforms including Facebook & YouTube pertaining a state-of-the-art geo-blocking. This means the streams should be only available within the host territory.

More particularly, the National Federations shall respect the following requirements:

- To inform the CEV Digital & TV department of their wish to produce matches minimum 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
- To respect CEV production standards including number of cameras & integration of the CEV official TV graphics package (TV graphics are provided by the CEV).
- To provide CEV and relevant partners the signal of the produced matches via Internet (RTMP) or via satellite delivery (Eutelsat carrier).

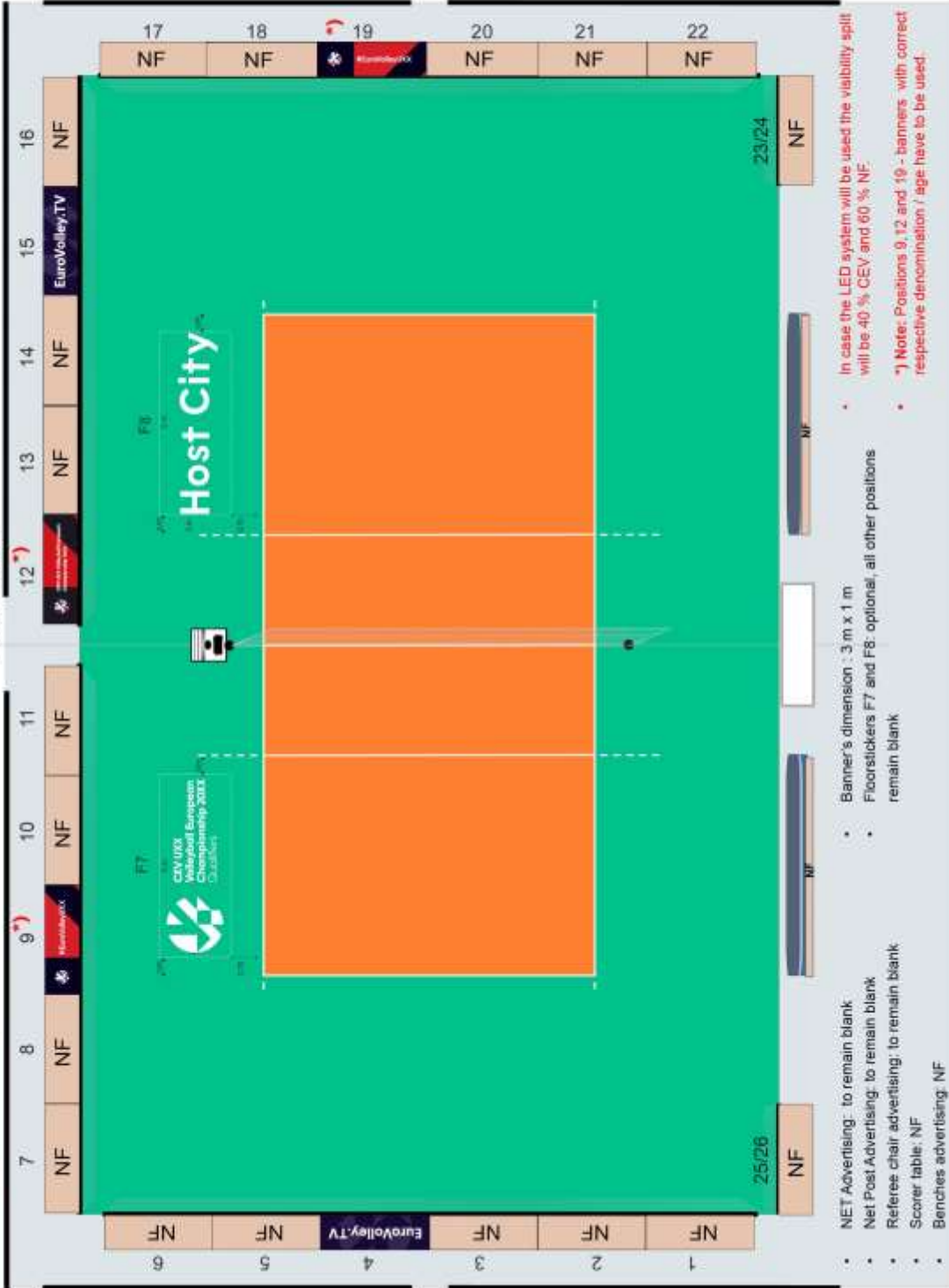

Thus, gambling and betting services are prohibited and the category will not be released by the CEV.

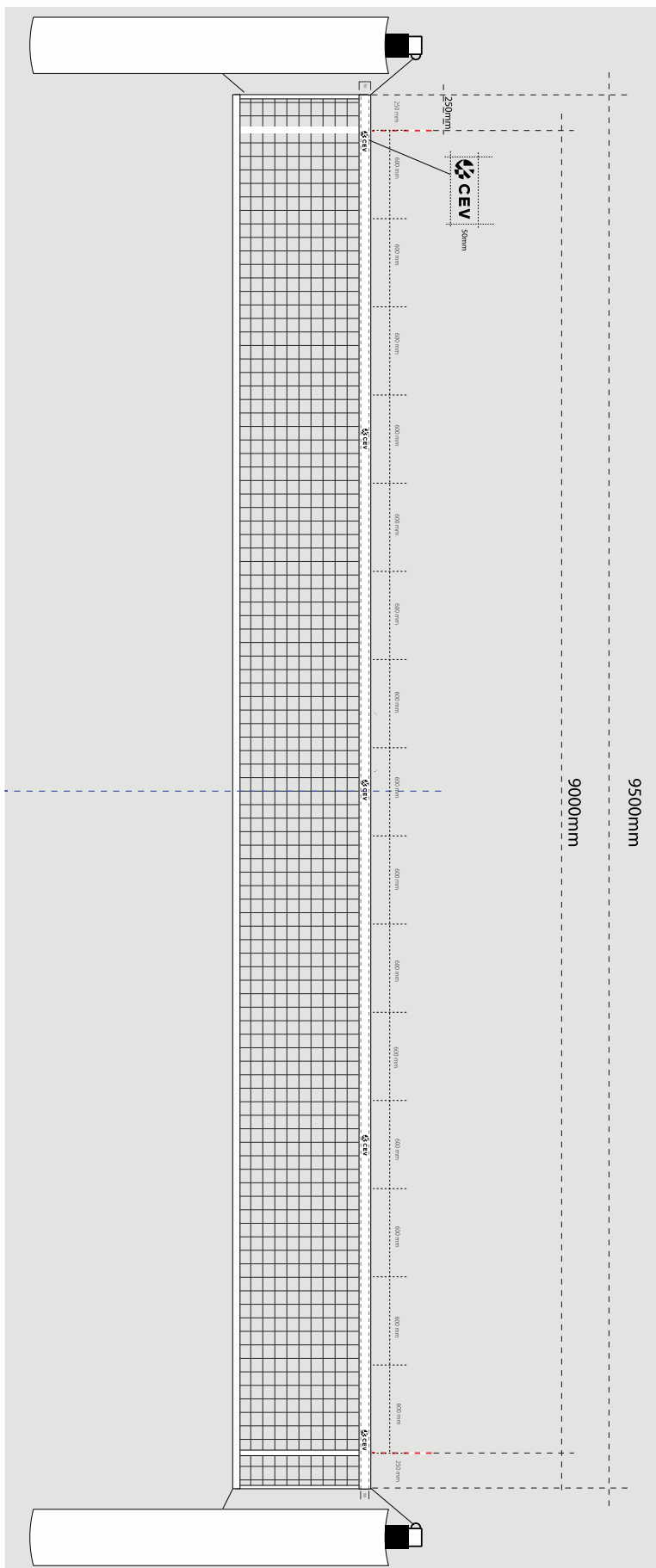
7. FIVB World Championships 2023 – U21W/U21M

After the decision by the FIVB Board of Administration regarding the adjustment of the FIVB Volleyball Age Group World Championships, the FIVB will align the age groups between the genders as of 2023 and onwards.

This means that starting from the 2023 edition, the World Championships will be open to both Women's Under 21 and Men's Under 21, i.e. for athletes born on or after 1 January 2003.

Based on the current information received from FIVB, the FIVB granted slots to CEV remain 2 per gender for the 2023 edition of the Women's U21 and Men's U21 World Championships. Those respective Finals will be played with 16 teams in total and will be composed of 10 teams in total from Confederations Championships plus the organiser and 5 teams not yet qualified per respective Age Group World Ranking on 1 January 2023.
